- **European Values:** Deeper understanding and appreciation of European values such as democracy, human rights, and the rule of law.



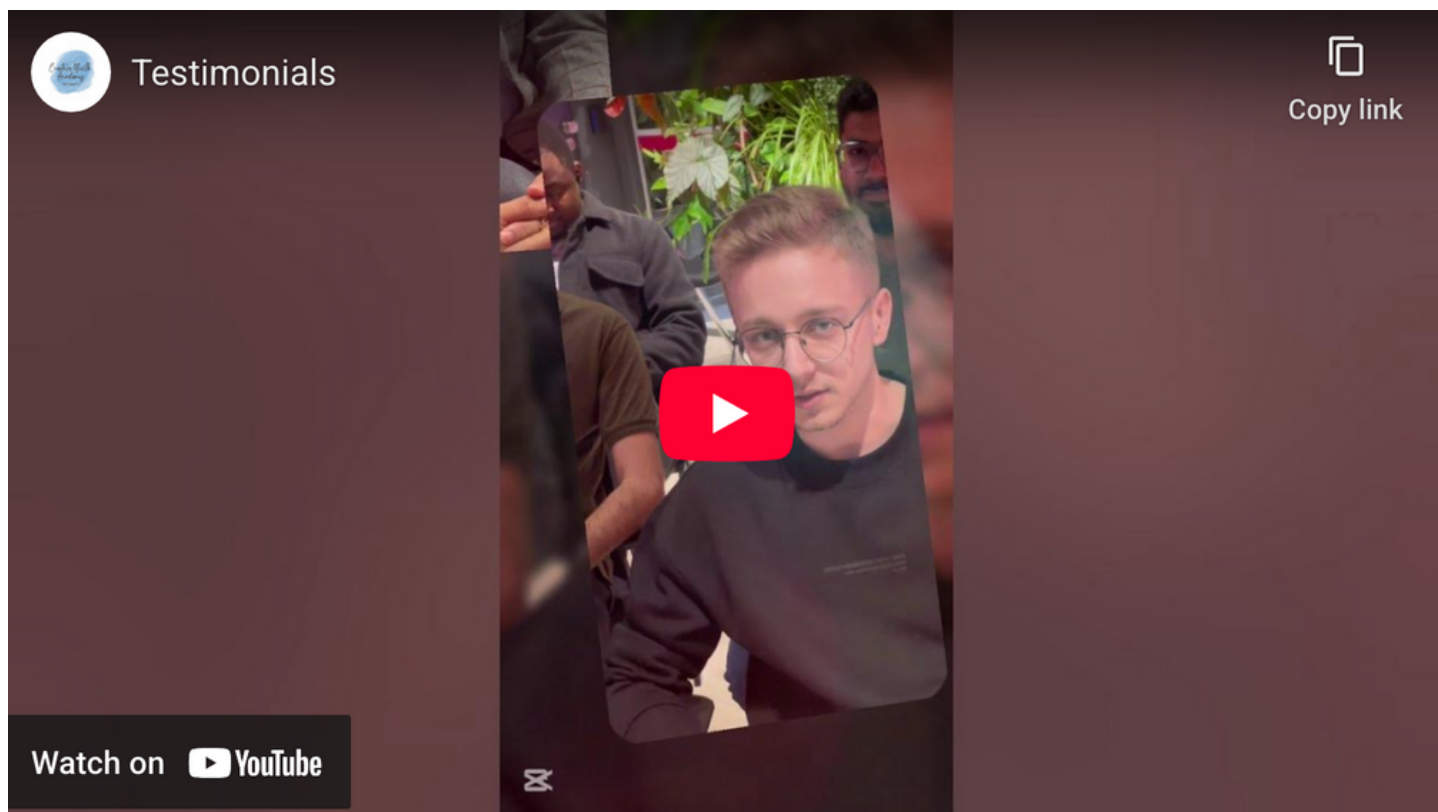
